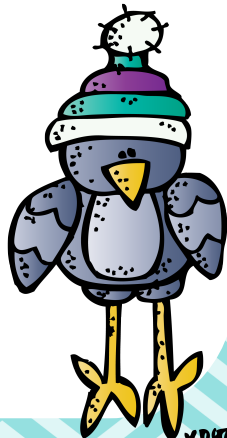
2 On a cold night, Trina read 84 pages of the 342 page book. The next night, she read 97 pages. How many more pages are left in the book?

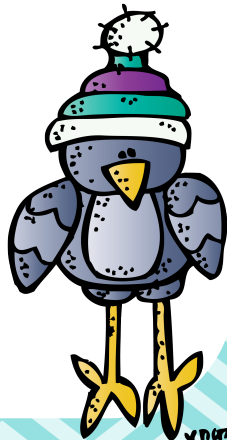
6 Freda played in the snow for 58 minutes. Brendan played in the snow for 17 more minutes than Freda. How long did they both spend playing in the snow?
